





2018 BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTION RESULTS

Vantage West held its board election during the 63rd Annual Membership Meeting on August 6.

Incumbent Directors Ana Archer and Dr. Paul Melendez were re-elected by acclamation for new 3-year terms, filling the two seats that were up for regular election. A special election was held for a third board seat vacated earlier this year. Olivia Smith was elected by the Membership to complete the remaining 2 years of the vacated third seat's term.
